Our Board of Directors and Staff would like to remind our membership of our policies regarding golf course rules and etiquette. Please help keep your club enjoyable for everyone by adhering to these policies :

## DINING

From formal to informal, indoor or outdoor, business lunch or lunch after golf, a special occasion large or small, our spacious dining areas offer everything you need. They include:

**FIREPLACE ROOM** - our formal dining area with cloth napkins and tablecloths. **LOUNGE** - our upscale informal dining and bar area.

- **PAVILION** the most informal area. Please try to utilize this area for after golf and if dressed at the lower end of our suggested dress code.
- **LEGENDS (19th Hole)** our snack area before, during and after golf with beverages available to take on the golf course.

**OUTDOOR PATIOS** are perfect in season for evening or pool dining.

The dining dress code policy is "**Respectfully Casual**". Formal golf attire, collared dress or casual shirts, logo golf shirts, sweaters and even your dress denim in good condition with finished seams are acceptable. Coat and tie is always an option. CWCC discourages tee shirts, swimsuits, tank and halter tops , hoodies, gym shorts and any garment that has words, terms or pictures that may be offensive. **Please remove all headgear if you are dining in the Fireplace Room or Lounge.**

**GOLF** Please respect our policy regarding proper golf attire . Collared shirts required. Some non-collared tech shirts are acceptable provided they are not graphic and in good condition. Traditional ladies sleeveless golf blouses are acceptable. Traditional golf shorts, ladies golf skirts or pants and hemmed denim in good condition are acceptable. Ladies please refrain from wearing tank tops, gym shorts or short skirts and shorts. Spike less golf shoes are required and tennis shoes are discouraged. NO STEEL SPIKES OR ATHLETIC CLEATED SHOES ALLOWED.

## **GOLF COURSE RULES**

- $\Rightarrow$  All players (members & guests) must register in the Golf Shop.
- ⇒ Guests must be registered with name and address on our golf guest register. A Crestwood member may have multiple guests in the same day. However, a particular guest is limited to one time per month. (Example non-member John Doe may only play one time per month.)
- $\Rightarrow$  Members are responsible for paying or signing for their own golf cart fees. If not, staff will bill accordingly .
- $\Rightarrow$  All groups are requested to play in **under four hours.**
- Five balls in play per group maximum. Six golfers MAY be allowed under strict permission from the Golf Shop Staff. These groups will be required to agree in advance to the established pace of play at CWCC of three hours and 50 minutes for 18 holes. If your group is not keeping up with the self-monitored pace of play, you should split into two groups or expect to be split by the Golf Shop Staff.
- $\Rightarrow$  Groups smaller than four may be paired into full groups at the Pro's discretion.
- ⇒ Member owned golf carts shall not be driven around the property by drivers under the age of 16 unless accompanied by an adult. Rental cart drivers must be 16 years of age.
- $\Rightarrow$  Please double up on carts to save cart damage to the golf course.
- $\Rightarrow$  The 90 degree rule is always in effect unless **CARTS ON PATH ONLY** signs are posted.
- $\Rightarrow$  Play the golf course in the proper sequence 1,2,3,4 . . . you may begin on #10 at the Pro's permission.
- ⇒ Please limit your time in Legends at the turn to 5 minutes or less. You must keep your position on #10 tee or you may be required to restart on #1.
- ⇒ Junior golfers (age 11 and under) must be accompanied by an adult (18 or over) on weekends. The golf shop staff has the right to restrict junior play during busy times that the junior may not be able to handle.
- ⇒ Tee times are available for weekends and holidays and take priority. They may be booked by calling the Golf Shop one week in advance.
- $\Rightarrow$  All food and beverage consumed at Crestwood must be purchased from the club.

**GOLF COURSE HOURS SCHEDULE** All times are subject to weather and activity levels and may change at the discretion of Crestwood management.
